STEWARD SUMMARY

UPDATE 2: Final 17:00hrs Sunday 20th June 2010

Matters arising from Race 3:

Following a DSA investigation and an admission to a Breach of Rules – Careless Driving by Car #12 Liam Sager, the stewards imposed a penalty of a loss of five Championship points.

Following a DSA investigation and an admission to a Breach of Rules – Careless Driving by Car #76 Ben Jurczak, the stewards imposed a penalty of a loss of five Championship points.

Following a DSA investigation and an admission to a Breach of Rules – Control Line restart infringement by Car #27 Sam Howard on Car #17 Stefan Borsato, the stewards imposed a penalty of one finishing position, to amend the finishing result of Car #27 to 15th.

Following a Team's request for a DSA investigation into an incident involving Car #8 Tom Williamson on Car #6 Adam Graham at Turn 6, no Breach of the Rules was established.

Matters arising from Race 2:

Following a Team's request for a DSA investigation into an incident involving Car #5 Andre Borell on Car #27 Sam Howard, no Breach of the Rules was established.

Matters arising from Race 1:

The Black Flag for a drive through Pit Lane penalty was displayed to the following drivers;

- Car #55 Garry Jacobson failing to rejoin the circuit within an appropriate distance. (short cutting)
- Car #8 Tom Williamson for a driving infringement on Car #11 Cameron Waters.

Following a Team's request for a DSA investigation into an incident involving Car #71 Nathan Morcom on Car #55 Gary Jacobson at Turn 5, no Breach of the Rules was established.

Following a Steward's hearing Car #83 Matthew Brabham was found to be in Breach of the Rules – driving infringement, for an incident at Turn 1, and the stewards imposed a penalty of a loss of 5 Championship points fully suspended until the 31/12/2010.

Matters arising from Qualifying:

There were no issues from qualifying.

Matters arising from Practice #2:

Following an investigation and an admission to a Breach of Sporting Regulation v3, S13.2 - Tyre Nomination by Car #49 Jack LeBrocq, the stewards imposed a penalty exclusion from Practice #2 on Car #49.

Following an investigation and an admission to a Breach of Sporting Regulation v3, S13.2 - Tyre Nomination by Car #9 Zac Schonberger, the stewards imposed a penalty exclusion from Practice #2 on Car #9.

Following an investigation and an admission to a Breach of Sporting Regulation v3, S13.2 - Tyre Nomination by Car #55 Garry Jacobson, the stewards imposed a penalty exclusion from Practice #2 on Car #55.

Matters arising from Practice #1:

Following a Steward's hearing Car #2 Geoff Uhrhane, was found to be in Breach of Sporting Regulation v3 S13.2 - Tyre Nomination, and the stewards imposed a penalty of exclusion from Practice #1 on Car #2.

Following a Steward's hearing Car #16 Ryan Simpson, was found to be in Breach of Sporting Regulation v3S13.2 - Tyre Nomination, and the stewards imposed a penalty of exclusion from Practice #1 on Car #16.

Following an investigation and an admission to a Breach of Sporting Regulations v3 S12.4a - Parc Ferme by Car #13 Nick Foster, the stewards imposed a penalty exclusion from Practice #1 on Car #13.
